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Beyond the avatar:

We consider 22 steps of evolution; beyond that, evolution itself ceases to exist:

Step 23: VishJiv

The concept of life and will applies to every object. It is not limited to the universe but encompasses all that exists. You stop identifying what is labeled as alive or life because there is will, and it moves everything. It is not necessarily individual will but the flow of the will of everything. If everything manifested has life, then life does not exist—it is merely manifested reality.

Step 24: SiddhiNanda

Perfection is absolutely manifested.

Step 25: Gayatri

There is no trinity. Therefore, the "one" does not exist—only reality. The empowered duality (2), combined with power (5), becomes the tool (7). This is the central point of the Sri Yantra.

Step 26: Budh Dhahara

Buddha, Dhahara—the center of form. The architect.

Step 27: Taragni

That which gave will to form, to the world.

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
